SCHOOL MEALS

From 1st April 2018 the government have introduced a Universal Credit threshold of £7400 per year for free school meal (FSM) eligibility. All children who currently receive FSM have not been affected.

When your child is registered for FSM they are entitled to a yearly sum of money in Dchool. If you know that you could be eligible, please apply on-line: "CCC Citizen's Portal."
