Our main topic this term is Ancient Egypt.



English

To begin with, we will be creating poetry using haikus about nature and the Ancient Egyptians. Later, we will be looking at ancient versions of traditional tales in the to produce some narrative writing.

After half term we will be focussing on non-chronological reports based on our topic.

During guided reading, we will be looking at The Twits and Secrets of a Sun King. We will be building on all the skills we have learnt during the year and challenging ourselves and putting them into practice.

We will be having a big push on spelling, grammar and comprehension this term to ensure children are ready for their next school year.

Maths

In the summer term, our focus will be on fractions, decimals (Y4), money, time, Roman Numerals (Year 4) and graphs (Year 3). To support your child at home, it would be great to make sure you regularly refer to the time and show your child what the time looks like on a clock in preparation for this half term. It is great to see so many children engaging with Mathletics through choice (it is expected that ALL children complete the 2 set tasks each week) and having a go at TTRockstars. We have a few Rock Heroes and Legends among us and it would be great to see even more children achieve this. In June, Year 4 will be completing their times tables check as set out by the Government. 10 minutes per day on TTRockstars will help your child to achieve this.

PE

This term we will be making the most of our outdoor space as much as possible. Please make sure that your child has a hoodie/tracksuit in case of cool weather.
